Citizen's Time: David King spoke about rubbish; grass clippings and yard waste, being dumped on the property next to him on Steamburg Drive causing health discomfort to his family and rodents damaging his home. Laveta assured him that she will talk to our zoning department.

Heather King continued the conversation by asking why the laws against this behavior is not being enforced. Three different land owners continue to dump rubbish from their property to this land for the past 4 years.
