VOTING METHOD #1

ABSENTEE

Any registered voter can vote with an absentee ballot. There is no longer a reason required.

There are 2 steps to this process: 1) Submit a ballot application

by mail or with the Township Clerk
(unless you have previously submitted a
permanent ballot application)

2) Return your voted ballot

by mail or place in absentee ballot drop box (location listed on front of brochure)

Permanent Absentee Voter Ballot List Info:

Voters who want to automatically be mailed a ballot for all future elections (and skip the application step) may sign up for the Permanent AV Ballot List anytime at Mi.gov/Vote or when submitting an Absent Voter Ballot Application.

The Permanent AV <u>Application</u> List that has been in place for the last decade or so is being phased out per direction by the State. The Permanent AV <u>Ballot</u> List will replace it.
