## Options for Voter Registration (or Updating Address):

## Voter Registration Deadlines:

- **Online or by mail:**  
Up to 15 days before election
- **In-person at the Clerk's Office:**  
Through election day (proof of  
residency required during 14 days  
prior to election day)

## 2024 Elections

Presidential Primary:

**February 27<sup>th</sup>**

Primary Election:

**August 6<sup>th</sup>**

General Election:

**November 5<sup>th</sup>**

**Early In-Person Voting Starts:**

11 days before election day (Saturday)

**Early In-Person Voting Ends:**

2 days before election day (Sunday)

**Absentee Timeline:**

Applications available:

75 days before election day

Ballots available to be issued:

45 days before election day

Applying by mail:

Recommended to submit at least 2  
weeks ahead of election day

Apply in-person:

Ends at 4:00pm the day before election  
day

**Absentee Ballots Due:**

**8:00pm on Election Day**

# VOTING METHOD #1

## ABSENTEE

Any registered voter can vote with an absentee ballot. There is no longer a reason required.

There are 2 steps to this process:

**1) Submit a ballot application**

by mail or with the Township Clerk (unless you have previously submitted a permanent ballot application)

**2) Return your voted ballot**

by mail or place in absentee ballot drop box (location listed on front of brochure)

**BALLOTS MUST ARRIVE AT CLERK'S OFFICE BEFORE 8:00 PM ON ELECTION DAY**

**Absentee Application Options:**

- Online at Mi.gov/Vote
- Request from the Clerk's office
- Visit the Township Website

Returning your ballot to the Township Clerk or utilizing the drop box is strongly recommended instead of mailing – especially during the last week prior to election day.

**THE OUTSIDE OF THE BALLOT ENVELOPE MUST BE SIGNED**

# VOTING METHOD #2

## IN-PERSON – EARLY ✓

Any registered voter can vote during the 9 days early voting period for all state and federal elections.

### Permanent Absentee Voter Ballot List Info:

Voters who want to automatically be mailed a ballot for all future elections (and skip the application step) may sign up for the Permanent AV Ballot List anytime at Mi.gov/Vote or when submitting an Absent Voter Ballot Application.

*The Permanent AV Application List that has been in place for the last decade or so is being phased out per direction by the State. The Permanent AV Ballot List will replace it.*

# VOTING METHOD #3

## IN-PERSON ON

### ELECTION DAY ✓

**Polls are open  
7 AM – 8 PM on Election Day**

Vote at your assigned precinct as noted on your Voter Information Card\*, check Mi.gov/Vote for precinct locations, or call the Township Clerk Office.

*\* New Voter Info. Cards will be mailed to each registered voter with their early voting site & precinct locations. This "ID" card is for voter information purposes only and is not a substitute for a valid state issued photo ID when voting in-person.*

*(due to new Senate Bills 572 & 573 set the maximum precinct size at 4,999, and did receive immediate effect – meaning Leroy Township will have just one Precinct now for all voters)*
