NEWTON TOWNSHIP ROAD IMPROVEMENT, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Shall Newton Township impose a new additional 3-mill tax millage (\$3.00 dollars per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec 6 of the Michigan Constitution? And shall it levy these mills for a period of 15 years from 2024 through 2038 for the purpose of township road improvement, repair and maintenance? These mills will raise an estimated \$439,000.00 of revenue in the first year the millage is authorized and levied.
